

Part-Time Enrollment - Financial Aid Regulation

I understand that to remain eligible for Rutgers need-based grant aid (e.g., RAG, RTG) I must be enrolled full-time, unless I am enrolled in my final term and carrying the credits I need to graduate. Further, I understand that I will need to contact the Office of Financial Aid to notify that office that I am in my final term.

I understand that to remain eligible for Rutgers merit-based grant aid (e.g., Carr, OSRP, Rutgers College Scholar-Athlete) I must be enrolled full-time, unless I am enrolled in my final term and carrying the credits I need to graduate. Further, I understand that I will need to contact the Office of Financial Aid to notify that office that I am in my final term.

I understand that to remain eligible for federal financial aid loans (e.g., Stafford and Perkins) I must be enrolled in a minimum of 6 credits.

I understand that to be eligible for a NJ Tuition Aid Grant (TAG) I must be enrolled full-time, unless I am enrolled in my final term and carrying the credits (i.e., minimum of 6 credits) I need to graduate. Further, I understand that I will need to contact the Office of Financial Aid to notify that office that I am in my final term. I also understand that the maximum TAG award that I can receive can not exceed my tuition charges.

I understand that to be eligible for a Supplemental Education Opportunity Grant (SEOG) I must be enrolled in a minimum of 6 credits. I also understand that my SEOG award will be prorated based on my new reduced financial need, which is calculated on my cost of attendance or budget.

I understand my PELL grant award will be prorated based on the number of credits I am enrolled in (i.e., 12 or more credits – maximum PELL qualified to receive; 9-11 credits – 75% of PELL qualified to receive; 6-8 credits – 50% of PELL qualified to receive; less than 6 credits – based on need).

I understand that my athletics scholarship award can not exceed my actual tuition, fees, room and board charges. Example: Student A is awarded a \$10,000.00 athletics scholarship for the spring term. Student A is in his final term and is enrolled in 6 credits. Student A's tuition, fees, room and board charges for the spring term is \$8,000.00. The maximum athletics scholarship that can be awarded to Student A for that term is \$8,000.00.

Part-Time Enrollment Insurance Regulation

I understand that part-time students are not covered under the university's student health insurance policy. Further, I understand that if I do not apply for and purchase the university's basic student health insurance all medical charges for non-athletic related issues will become my responsibility.
