#### Galactic Ballroom, Moon Palace Resort • Cancun, Mexico

**TV:** The game will be televised live on the CBS Sports Network with Thad Anderson calling the action and Pete Gillen offering the analysis.

**Radio:** The contest will be broadcast live on the Rutgers Radio Network, WOR 710 AM in New York and WCTC 1450 AM in New Brunswick. Chris Carlin will serve as play-by-play announcer and Dick Lloyd will provide commentary. WRSU (88.7) will also broadcast the game.

Rutgers meets Atlantic 10 Conference member Richmond in a 6 p.m. local (7 p.m. ET) tip-off on Wednesday evening at the Moon Palace Resort's Galactic Ballroom in the consolation game of the 2011 Triple Crown Cancun Challenge. In their history the Scarlet Knights have played multiple times outside of the continental United States in Hawaii, but the match-ups in Cancun mark the first regular season games in RU men's basketball history to require a passport.

Wednesday evening's contest will mark the first meeting on the collegiate hardwood between the Scarlet Knights and Spiders. RU is 180-168 all-time against current members of the Atlantic 10 Conference. Rutgers was a member of the league from 1976-77 until 1994-95 before joining the BIG EAST.

Rutgers, under the direction of second-year head coach Mike Rice, is coming off a hard fought 76-70 loss to Illinois State (3-1) Tuesday evening. Junior forward Austin Johnson and freshman guard Eli Carter both scored 12 points in the defeat. The Scarlet Knights trailed by as many as 13 points in the second half, but battled back to take a 66-65 lead, its first of the game, with 3:16 on the clock. The teams battled back-and-forth before the Redbirds scored eight of the contest's final 10 points to capture the victory. Illinois State benefitted from a foul differential that saw the Redbirds attempt 38 free throws, of which they deposited 28. Rutgers attempted 18 from the charity stripe, making eight.

Sophomore forward Gilvydas Biruta leads in the Scarlet Knights in scoring with 11.6 points-per-game and rebounding with 7.8 boards-per-contest.

Richmond, under the leadership of seventh-year head coach Chris Mooney, is coming off a 70-61 loss to Illinois Tuesday evening. The Fighting Illini established a 38-25 rebounding advantage which resulted in a 24-12 differential in points in the paint. Three Spiders scored in double figures, including junior guard Darien Brothers, who had 22 points courtesy of six-of-nine shooting from behind the arc. Four spiders average double figures in scoring, including freshman guard Kendall Anthony with a team-best 16.0 points-per-game. Anthony is also shooting an impressive 90.3 percent (28-31) from the foul line.

## TRIPLE CROWN CANCUN CHALLENGE

The tournament features eight men's Division I college basketball teams broken into two divisions (Riviera and Mayan). Eight games are played in the U.S. where the four teams in the Riviera Division host the four schools in the Mayan Division. All eight teams then travel to Cancun, Mexico, for two games played at the all-inclusive Moon Palace Resort. A champion is crowned in both divisions.

This year's field is headlined by Illinois, Illinois State, Richmond, and Rutgers (Riviera Division). Hampton, Lipscomb, Sacred Heart, and Southern Illinois University Edwardsville round out the field (Mayan Division). Three teams competed in postseason play last year including: Richmond (NCAA Sweet 16), Illinois (NCAA 3rd Round) and Hampton (NCAA 1st Round loss to Duke).

All four games in the Riviera Division will be televised Live by the CBS Sports Network. Two games will be televised on Tuesday, Nov. 22 featuring Rutgers vs. Illinois State at 7 p.m. ET and Richmond vs. Illinois at 9:30 p.m. ET. On Wednesday, Nov. 23, the Riviera third-place game will be televised at 7 p.m. ET, and the Riviera Championship game at 9:30 p.m. ET.

## RICE COMPETING IN SHOTS FROM THE HEART

Mike Rice is one of 64 Division I men's basketball coaches participating in the Second Annual Shots from the Heart Tournament. The coaches will compete in a free-throw shooting contest to help raise awareness for the growing problem of heart disease. The event, which also includes a tournament for assistant coaches, benefits the Skip Prosser Foundation. The former Wake Forest head coach passed away on July 26, 2007 of a heart attack.

Coaches will not have to actually compete against each other on the same court. Each coach will shoot 25 free throws at his convenience. A member of the athletic department will tally the results and the coach with the most points advances. Shots 1-10 are worth 1 point, 11-15 are worth 2 points, 16-20 are worth 3 points, 21-24 are worth 4 points and shot 25 is worth 5 points. As such, there is possible total of 56 points.

### Game Notables:

- The Scarlet Knights have won 13 of the last 14 home openers, including the last five-straight.
- The win pushes Rutgers all-time record in season openers to 73-27.
- RU climbs to 3-1 all-time against Dartmouth, winning the last three contests in the series. Against the Ivy League, the Scarlet Knights now hold a 79-131 record.
- For the first time since Louisville on Feb. 22, 2011, Rutgers had just one player score double-figures.
- Dane Miller scored 10-plus points for the 34th time in his career, with 12 points. The junior added six rebounds.
- Miller led the squad in scoring for the sixth time in his career and the first since at Seton Hall (Jan. 22) last season. The junior paced RU in rebounding for the 26th time in his career.
- The Scarlet Knights led the Big Green wire-to-wire, the first time since March 2, 2011 at DePaul. RU led two teams from start to finish last season (NJIT, Dec. 1, 2010).
- The Rutgers defense held Dartmouth to 4-of-22 (.182) shooting from behind the arc and did not allow a field goal for the first 8:08 of the second half. The 18.2 percent shooting from three tied an opponent's game low from last season.
- Eli Carter and Myles Mack both earned their first starts in a Rutgers uniform. Dane Miller got the nod for a team-best 50th-straight contest.
- Carter, Mack, Malick Kone, Greg Lewis, Derrick Randall, and Jerome Seagears all saw their first action for the Scarlet Knights.
