Knight Notes

- The Rutgers wrestling team (12-5) hits the road to face Virginia on Saturday, Feb. 4 at 6 p.m. in Memorial Gym in Charlottesville, Va. The Scarlet Knights won the last meeting against the Cavaliers, claiming a 25-12 victory on Jan. 29, 2010.
- RU fell in recent action against West Virginia, dropping a close dual by a score of 21-18 on Jan. 29. **Billy Ashnault (South Plainfield, N.J.)** scored a fall in the loss.
- Rutgers next hosts the 2012 NWCA/Cliff Keen Division I National Duals, presented by Hibiclens and The Marines. The regional dual format, known as "Mat Mayhem", kicks off in the RAC on Saturday, Feb. 11 at 2 p.m.
- Individually, RU is led by **Mario Mason (Moorestown, N.J.)**, who sports a 16-1 record at 149 pounds. Zannetti has recorded a team-high 22 victories, with Ashnault following him with 19 wins. **Michael DeMarco (Lyndhurst, N.J.)** and Rinaldi have collected 18 wins.
- In his fifth season leading the Scarlet Knights, head coach **Scott Goodale** has compiled a 83-26-1 dual record.

Head Coach Scott Goodale



Scott Goodale enters his fifth season as the Rutgers head wrestling coach. Under Goodale's watch, 20 RU wrestlers have earned NCAA bids and 20 Scarlet Knights have placed at the Eastern Intercollegiate Wrestling Association (EIWA) Championships. RU has tallied an impressive 71-21-1 record during his first four years "On the Banks."

In 2010-11, RU reached new heights as a program, finishing the year as a top 10 program, ranking ninth in the NWCA/USA Today Coaches Poll after posting a school-record 21 victories against only two defeats. Rutgers continued its strong season at the 107th EIWA Championships where they placed third as a team, tying the best finish ever for the program. Additionally, the Scarlet Knights saw nine wrestlers place at the EIWA Championships, including Scott Winston who took home the 165-pound bracket crown. RU qualified a school-record tying eight individuals for the NCAA Championships.

Rutgers finished at No. 22 in the final 2009-10 NWCA/USA Today Division I Team Coaches Poll after posting a 19-5-1 record. Seven Scarlet Knights earned NCAA bids. The No. 22 ranking was the highest in school history at that point. The Goodale-led squad put together a 15-match unbeaten streak from early December to late February which was the longest streak in school history.

In 2008-09, Rutgers broke the school record for victories in a single season with a 20-7 mark in dual action. Three Scarlet Knights earned NCAA Championships bids, which at the time was the most for RU since 2004.

The Scarlet Knights tallied an 11-7 overall record and 5-3 mark in Eastern Intercollegiate Wrestling Association (EIWA) action in 2007-08. Two wrestlers reached the NCAA Championships. Goodale maximized his strong high school coaching background and brought in a recruiting class ranked nationally by *W.I.N. Magazine* (No. 3) and *Intermat* (No. 4).

Goodale's first recruiting class included *Intermat's* No. 2 overall senior recruit in Scott Winston, *Intermat's* 17th-best recruit in Trevor Melde and *USA Wrestling's* 19th-best 171-pound wrestler in Dan Rinaldi. Goodale was a three-time New Jersey "Coach of the Year" at Jackson Memorial High School in Jackson, N.J., before becoming the sixth coach in Rutgers wrestling history.

The Jackson, N.J., native took over the Rutgers program following an impressive seven-year stint as head coach at his alma mater, Jackson Memorial High School. In seven seasons, Goodale compiled an overall record of 155-16, leading his squad to the top ranking in the state in 2006 and 2007.

Goodale wrestled for Lock Haven University in Pennsylvania, earning his bachelor's degree in Health and Physical Education in 1995. He then went to New Jersey City University where he earned a certification in Special Education in 1997. As a collegiate wrestler, Goodale made three trips to the NCAA Championships, as well as placing second at the Eastern Wrestling League (EWL) Tournament twice in his career. Goodale finished with 99 wins at Lock Haven. Goodale and his wife Lisa are the parents of Shelby and Zachary, and reside in Toms River.

Rutgers and the Virginia Cavaliers

- Rutgers is 3-2 all-time against Virginia, including a 2-0 mark under head coach **Scott Goodale**.
- The Scarlet Knights first met the Cavaliers on the mat on Dec. 20, 1968. RU won the initial matchup in the series, 17-11.
- Rutgers and Virginia met two seasons ago in the RAC, with the Scarlet Knights dominating the 23rd-ranked Cavaliers by a score of 25-12. Five current Rutgers dual starters wrestled in the match, with three claiming victories.

Scouting the Cavaliers

- Virginia has wrestled to a 7-1 (4-1 ACC) record in 2011-12, including wins over Drexel (39-3) and North Carolina (24-10). RU turned away the Tar Heels by a score of 33-9 at the Northeast Duals on Nov. 26.
- The Cavaliers are led by 125-pounder Matt Snyder, 141-pounder Nick Nelson and 184-pounder Jon Fausey. Snyder has compiled an 18-3 record, while Nelson is tied for the team-lead in wins with a 19-2 record. Fausey has wrestled to a 17-4 mark this season.
- In recent action, No. 22 Virginia took down 13th-ranked Maryland, previously unbeaten at 13-0, by a dual score of 22-14 on Jan. 29. UVa won six of the 10 contested matches.

RU Drops to No. 24 Hofstra, 26-10

• The Rutgers wrestling team (12-4) fell to 24th-ranked Hofstra (9-0) by a score of 26-10 on Jan. 27 in College Ave. Gym. The Scarlet Knights were led by bonus-point performances from 174-pounder Greg Zannetti (Edison, N.J.) and 197-pounder Daniel Rinaldi (Lodi, N.J.). Zannetti scored a fall in 2:25 over Pride wrestler Jermaine John, while Rinaldi scored an 11-3 major decision win over Tim Murphy of Hofstra at 197 pounds.

No. 24 Rutgers Edges Navy, 20-19, Perrotti Scores Fastest Pin

• The 24th-ranked Rutgers wrestling team scored its fifth EIVA dual victory of the season Jan. 22 in the RAC, winning 20-19 over Navy. The dual match finished with a 19-19 tie, but the Scarlet Knights held a 37-33 advantage in total match points to record the additional team point and secure the win. **Anthony Perrotti (Roseland, N.J.)** and **Greg Zannetti (Edison, N.J.)** led the way for Rutgers by scoring bonus points at 149 pounds and 174 pounds, respectively.

• Perrotti's 13-second win by fall over Navy's Peyton Walsh was the fastest RU pin to date in the 2011-12 season. Zannetti scored a 16-6 major decision over Navy's James Mannier. RU fought back after facing a 12-9 deficit halfway through the dual.

No. 24 Rutgers Falls to No. 15 Lehigh, 26-9

Goodale Names Turner as Volunteer Coach

- RU head coach **Scott Goodale** named former Wisconsin All-American **Tyler Turner** to the position of volunteer coach, it was announced Sept. 29.
- Turner was a standout in his days at Wisconsin, placing sixth at 149 pounds at the 2007 NCAA Wrestling Championships in Auburn Hills, Mich. Turner battled to All-America honors as an unseeded wrestler, turning away four seeded opponents en route to the awards stand. He compiled a 93-41 overall record in his Badger career.

Rutgers Announces New Five-Year Contract for Scott Goodale

- Rutgers Director of Intercollegiate Athletics **Tim Perneti** announced June 1, 2011 that wrestling coach **Scott Goodale** has signed a new five-year contract. Goodale's new contract begins July 1, 2011 and runs through June 30, 2016.
- During his four years leading the Scarlet Knights, Goodale has built a foundation destined for national prominence. Goodale's program has progressed impressively, as evidenced by a school-record crowd of 5,011 that witnessed the top-10 matchup between RU and Lehigh in February of last season.

2010-11 Season Review

- Rutgers finished the 2010-11 season with a school-record 21 dual wins and No. 9 national ranking in the final NWCA/USA Today Final Coaches Poll. The Scarlet Knights also saw a school-record nine wrestlers place at the 107th EIWA Championships, including a champion in **Scott Winston (Jackson, N.J.)**. The 165-pounder's individual crown was the first for RU at the EIWA tournament since 2001.
- The Scarlet Knights tied a school record by sending eight wrestlers to the NCAA Championships. RU finished 27th in the tournament, with wrestlers Winston and **Mario Mason (Moorestown, N.J.)** at 149 pounds falling just one win shy of securing All-America honors in their respective bracket's "Round of 12."
- RU graduated a trio of seniors with NCAA experience who impacted the program in their time "On the Banks." Alex Caruso qualified for his third NCAA Championships at 174 pounds last season. Caruso totaled a team-leading 33 victories in 2010-11. Daryl Cocozzo, a three-time NCAA qualifier, totaled 104 career victories (56 at RU, 48 at Edinboro). As a senior, Cocozzo was a standout at 157 pounds, winning 29 matches. At heavyweight, D.J. Russo finished his career with 104 wins. Last season, he earned his third trip to the NCAA Championships.
